You will read and sign Pueblo School for Arts and Sciences' (PSAS) Student Technology Agreement before taking procession of the Property. You will comply at all times with PSAS' Student Technology Agreement, the Student Handbook and Acceptable Use Policy, incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof for all purposes. Any failure to comply may terminate your rights of possession effective immediately and PSAS may repossess the property.

- Legal title to the property is Pueblo School for Arts and Sciences' and shall at all times remain in the PSAS Charter Network. Your right of
 possession and use is limited to and conditioned upon your full and complete compliance with this Agreement and the Student
 Technology Agreement.
- The computer/device shall be available to the student for appropriate educational use as described in the PSAS Student Technology Usage Policy; Students must abide by all policy's in the Student Handbook (Technology Agreement on Page 20)
- The parent and/or legal guardian gives consent, presented with reasonable cause, to search PSAS assigned technology accounts, devices
 and/or associated media. This includes local, external or web-based drives and file storage, USB storage devices, and portable memory
 cards.
- The student shall make no attempt to physically maintain, adjust, repair, or alter the computer. For any issues, the PSAS IT Dept must be contacted immediately at www.psask8.org/technicalsupport
- On campus loss or damage must be reported immediately to administrative personnel. Off campus loss or theft must be reported within 24 hours to appropriate law enforcement and a report needs to be filed. A copy of the filed report must be turned into school administrators by the next business and/or school day.
- Your right to use and possession of the property terminates not later than the last day of the school year unless earlier terminated by
 PSAS or upon withdrawal from PSAS. A fee of \$10 per day may be assessed for devices not returned according to the terms of this
 Agreement.

If you do not fully comply in a timely manner with all terms of this Agreement and the Student Technology agreement, including the timely return of the property, PSAS shall be entitled to declare you in default and come to your place of residence, or other location of the property, to take possession of the property. If a transfer to another school takes place, you will have 24 hours to return the device to its home school.

I understand and will abide by the above Agreement. I further understand that a violation of the PSAS Technology Policy the regulations above is unethical and may constitute a criminal offense. Should my student commit any violation, my student's access privileges may be revoked, and further disciplinary action and/or appropriate legal action may be taken.
